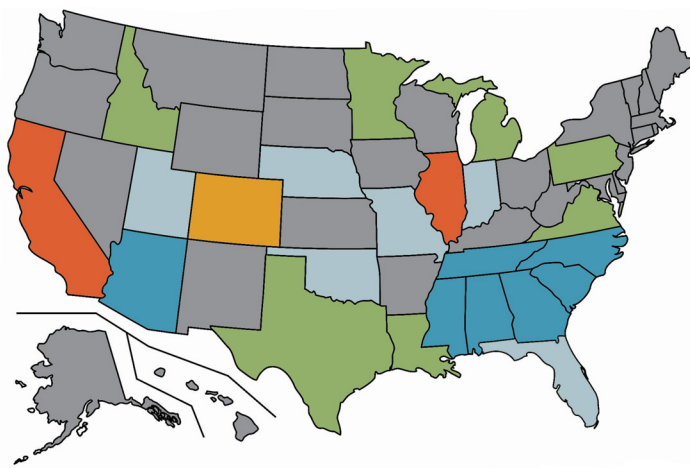

SUCCESSFUL E-VERIFY IMPLEMENTATION

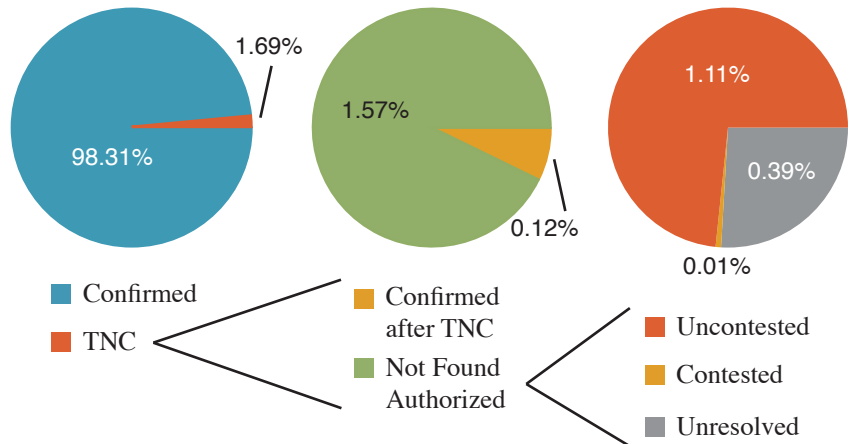


- Requires the use of E-Verify for all or nearly all employees
- Requires public contractors and/or state agencies to use E-verify
- Requires some public contractors and/or state agencies to use E-verify
- Allows an alternative to E-Verify
- No legislation supporting or opposing E-verify
- Legislation supporting or opposing E-verify
