FY2008 data was not archived so data will not match historical totals; data for FY2008 was run on IIDS 7/22/2010 Cases closed after 10/01/2009 were not included FY2009-FY2012 data is historical and remains static FY2013 YTD Data is updated as of 03/16/2013 (IIDS v 1.12 as of 03/18/2013, EID Extract as of 03/16/2013)

Returns include Voluntary Returns, Voluntary Departures and Withdrawals Under Docket Control

Case Category is a manual selection based upon officer input entered into Enforce For example, although there are 20 removals identified as Terrorist Court Cases for FY 2008 to FY 2013 (YTD), those cases have been identified as data quality errors

FY2009-FY2012 Submission, Matches, and Removal Data are historical and remains static.

SC Interop Cases BQY was re-run in IIDS v1.12 on 03/12/2013 and the SC Interop Queries BQYs were re-run in IIDS v1.12 on 03/12/2013.

Alien Submissions are defined as all fingerprint submissions that have been processed through ICE use of SC IDENT/IAFIS interoperability.

**Alien IDENT Matches.**

Alien IDENT Matches are defined as Aliens that had a match in the IDENT system and who were charged with or convicted of any level offense. IDENT Matches include duplicate entries for cases as an individual may go through interoperability several times for one unique case.

**LESC L1 (Level 1)** includes aliens who have been charged or convicted of an aggravated felony at the time of the IDENT match.

**LESC L2/3 (Level 2/3)** includes aliens who have been charged or convicted of a crime other than an aggravated felony at the time of the IDENT match.

**SC Removals**

SC Removals are defined as aliens that had a match in IDENT and were removed. Threat levels are based on the levels described in "Civil Immigration Enforcement: Priorities for the Apprehension, Detention and Removal of Aliens," which, "[f]or purposes of prioritizing the removal of aliens convicted of crimes" and are retroactively applied to all data.

**Convicted Criminals L1 (Level 1)** includes aliens convicted of "aggravated felonies," as defined in § 101(a)(43) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, or two or more crimes punishable by more than one year, commonly referred to as "felonies"

**Convicted Criminals L2 (Level 2)** includes aliens convicted of any felony or three or more offenses punishable by less than one year, commonly referred to as "misdemeanors".

**Convicted Criminals L3 (Level 3)** includes aliens convicted of offenses punishable by less than one year.

**EWI, Visa Violators and Overstays** includes aliens that do not have a recorded criminal conviction confirmed by ICE, are not classified as ICE fugitives or prior removals or returns. Examples include aliens who entered the United States without inspection, were present in the United States without inspection, or violated/overstayed the terms of their visa/admission. These individuals may have a criminal conviction, but ICE does not currently have data confirming a conviction.

**ICE Fugitives** includes aliens that do not have a recorded criminal conviction confirmed by ICE, but have failed to leave the United States following the issuance of a final order of removal, deportation, or exclusion. These individuals may have a criminal conviction, but ICE does not currently have data confirming a conviction.

Returns include Voluntary Returns, Voluntary Departures and Withdrawals Under Docket Control.

Starting in FY2009, ICE began to "lock" removal statistics on October 5th at the end of each fiscal year and counted only the aliens whose removal or return was already confirmed. Aliens removed or returned in that fiscal year but not confirmed until after October 5th were excluded from the locked data and thus from ICE statistics. To ensure an accurate and complete representation of all removals and returns, ICE will include the removals and returns confirmed after October 5th into the next fiscal year. The number of removals in FY2009, excluding the "lag" from FY2008, was 387,790. The number of removals in FY2010, excluding the "lag" from FY2009, was 373,440.
