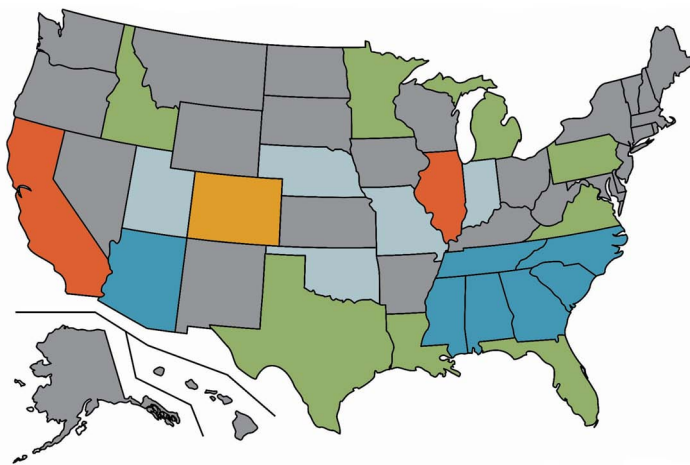


E-VERIFY FACT SHEET

SUCCESSFUL E-VERIFY IMPLEMENTATION

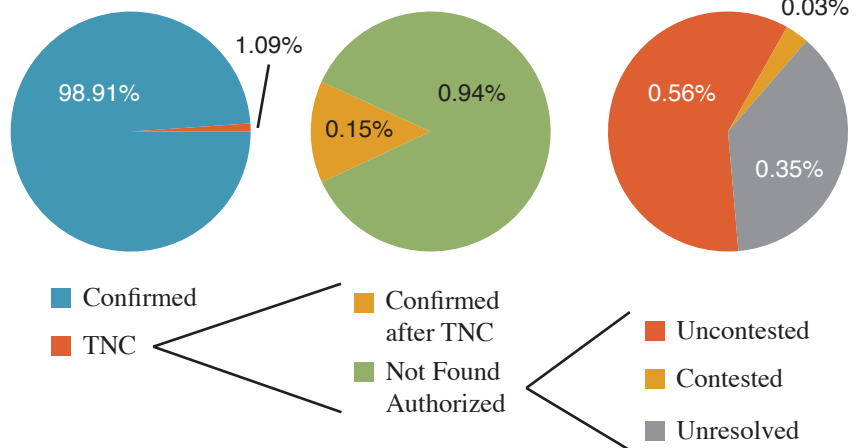


- Requires the use of E-Verify for all or nearly all employees
- Requires public contractors and/or state agencies to use E-verify
- Requires some public contractors and/or state agencies to use E-verify
- Allows an alternative to E-Verify
- No legislation supporting or opposing E-verify
- Legislation supporting or opposing E-verify

Social Security Number Verification System: Critical Tool to Ensure Integrity of Payroll Records

- SSNVS is a free online service that allows users to verify that the Social Security numbers of all employees match SSA records.
- Flags clerical errors and many forms of identity fraud.
- In FY 2017, the SSA reported that approximately 33,000 had submitted about 171 million verifications, up from 111 million in 2013.
- Using SSNVS is a recommended “best practice” by ICE to help employers avoid hiring unauthorized workers.

E-Verify Enrollment Explodes
