

ALFALLAJ's Fingerprints were found on al Qaeda Mujahedeen Data Form

14. On or about March 21, 2017, investigators of the FBI requested fingerprint analysis of some of the Mujahedeen Data Forms discovered from the aforementioned December 8, 2001 raid.

15. On or about November 3, 2017, the FBI's Latent Print Operation Unit confirmed a positive match for 15 latent fingerprints belonging to **ALFALLAJ** on one of the Mujahedeen Data

Forms.³ The fingerprint matches came from prints that **ALFALLAJ** was required to provide when applying for his pilot's license in October 2016. **ALFALLAJ's** fingerprints were found on pages two, three, and five of the five-page form. The questions on the form are written in Arabic and the responses are also written in Arabic. An FBI linguist translated the form from Arabic to English. The kunya listed on the form is "Muthana Al-Najdi" who claims to be from Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, **ALFALLAJ's** city of birth. The Mujahedeen Data Form is signed with a date of September 2000.⁴ Additionally, the emergency contact information listed on the Mujahedeen Data Form includes a
