I have lived in security in the heart my enemy tribes for 17 yrs and I was survived many deadly diseases such as cholera, malaria and diarrheas before I immigrated to USA as a refugee in 2007, I never seen my family for 30 years which I thought one day they will reunited with me in USA but it did not happen while I lived in USA for 6 yrs without felony, I worked so hard, I paid tax and also I used to send money to my family because I was the only one -

YOUR HONOR

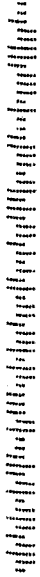
